☐ 1. Moray Eel Found on the bottom of the ocean in dark reef recesses or in sand. Snake like shape.	☐ 6. Porgy Fish (2) Live in shallow temperate marine water, are bottom-dwelling carnivores and swim and hover around reefs.
☐ 2. Tiger Shark Cruises all waters as a solitary figure, has stripes and is considered the garbage can of the sea.	■ 7. Clown Fish Have strips on their body and like to make their homes in anemones. Anemones protect the fish from intruders. They have a symbiotic relationship.
■ 3. Triggerfish Brightly colored with small teeth, 8-10 inches that inhabits and prowls low sections of outer reefs. Don't get too near a momma protecting its eggs, it can and will display some angry behavoir.	
	■ 8. Brown Garden Eels (2) Head and body extend from sand. They live in colonies. Very shy creatures.

Family of large marine crustaceans burrows on the sea floor.	Very invasive to all waters.
☐ 5. Big Eye Scad Bright reflective silver fish that swims rapidly in large schools. Fished commercially, both for human consumption and for bait.	☐ 10. Sea shells lying on the reef (2) Some are considered mollusks. The shell is used as their mobile home in the ocean.
